1. Relevance and importance of the scientific work presented for the attaining of the academic rank Associate Professor

The main point of view here is of the fashion-creator-experimenter, who performs presentation-demonstration of fashion art in the modern era, correlated with socio-economic changes, technical and technological development, and the general process of modernization in the evolution of social and cultural life in Bulgaria nowadays.

2. Works and documentation submitted for the habilitation

The presented works, documentation and researches clearly outline the overall picture of the creative and research pursuits of Christina Savova, PhD, highlighting her interests in various modern and experimental styles.

Based on the creative approach outlined, Christina Savova PhD brilliantly presents the aesthetic and stylistic studies, events, results and research. In her work dominates the creative, experimental and theoretical beginning, the view and the assessment of

the practitioner and the educator of fashion design, striving to enrich the theory and practice of fashion with different modern perspectives and deepen in the study of the various possibilities of contemporary fashion styles. This is a huge contribution to the works submitted for rehabilitation.

3. Main contributions of the habilitation work

Contributions of the habilitation work Contemporary Fashion Styles Formation Development Trends:

- 1. For the first time in Bulgaria a complete presentation of styles and fashion trends is presented
- 2. General description, history, characteristic features of contemporary styles are presented
- 3. The concepts of style and fashion, their laws of formation and duration are specified
- 4. The view of fashion changes as an elementary process is rejected, based on the complex interaction between socio-cultural factors, as well as their influence on the characteristics of the product and the users, from their tendency to quickly adopt new trends
- 5. A detailed analysis of the fashion style and its life cycle has been made, with many original details for its development, popularity and frequency of acceptance
- 6. The opinion of the manifestation of contemporary fashion as an accessible and flexible means of

expressing modernity is maintained logically and reasonably

7. Selected styles, which have appeared in the fashion trends in recent years and those that have influenced the development of contemporary fashion, are considered. They reveal the similarities and differences of fashion and style, the influence of fashion trends and their formation.

The habilitation work and creativity on graphic art have not been done in Bulgarian academic and university community so far and are rare and exceptional even in the foreign academic environment. In presenting, an interdisciplinary perspective on the chosen issue consists one of the major, important points that the present work is able to excellently highlight.

In this sense, the applicant's scientific and creative activity is based, as we have noted above, on a syncretic approach to the problem, combining, in my opinion, creative, practical, cultural, philosophical and other points of view and methods.

The habilitation work elaboration shows that the approach and the research and creative method are well founded and help to solve and achieve the goals and tasks set by the habilitation work presented.
